

## Carroll Hardee

The Rev. Carroll Sidney Hardee was born in Liberty County on Jan. 14, 1909. He died Sunday, Oct. 25, 2009, at the Hospice of the Golden Isles.

The Rev. Hardee came to Brunswick on two occasions in quest of employment. His second trip proved successful, as he obtained employment with the Creosol Plant in Brunswick. He returned to Thomas Creek and married his childhood sweetheart from Emanuel County, Macedonia Cross. This marriage was one of love and caring with God as the leader. This union lasted for 76 years. With his new bride in tow, he returned to Brunswick.

While in Brunswick he mastered the trade of welding, and worked for R. A. Jones Ship Building Co., Hercules Powder Inc., and retired from the Kut Kwick Corp., 38 years ago.
