COLORED TEACHER PASSES SUDDENLY

While seated at the piano conducting her music class, Luda [sic] D. Holmes, colored, teacher of music and history at Risley High School, became suddenly ill. Removed to the City Hospital for treatment, she died shortly after arriving. Her death cast a shadow of gloom over the campus of this well known Brunswick colored school. She had taught at the school for a number of years and had established a splendid record.

She was the wife of Wenell Holmes and the daughter of Henry Dent, both well known colored residents of the city. The body will lie in state at the school auditorium Sunday from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. Funeral services will be held at Grace Methodist church Sunday afternoon at 2:00 o'clock.
