DEATH OF THE PILOT OF THE WANDERER-Brunswick, January 5-[Special]

Captain James Clubb, one of the oldest pilots in port died today, aged 63 years. Captain Clubb was born on Cumberland Island, and was the first keeper of old Cumberland lighthouse. He piloted the Wanderer into port when she brought the last cargo of slaves that landed on the continent. She was consigned to Charles Lamar, Savannah, but landed on Jekyll Island.
