RUNAWAY HORSE CAUSES DEATH-Doctor Madden of Brunswick, Is Thus Killed.

Brunswick, Ga., February 19 [Special] Dr. J.M. Madden, one of Brunswick's most prominent citizens, was killed in a runaway today, from the result of which he died a short time afterwards. A horse became frightened and dashed down the street at a rapid rate of speed, throwing Dr. Madden heavily to the ground. He was picked up and removed to his residence, dying a short time afterwards. He leaves his wife and three children-Mrs. W.C. Hatcher of Columbus, J.M. Madden, Jr. of Jacksonville, and Mrs. R.B. Tupper of this city.
