Putnam Hickman

Putnam C. Hickman enlisted as a private on 28 December 1861 in Macon for the 30th GA Co. D and was promoted to a 4th Corporal on 14 May 1862. On 1 November 1863 he was listed as a Confederate Deserter and took the Oath of Allegiance to the U.S. Government that same month and year.

On 30 December 1863, a Putnam C. Hickman enlisted as a private in Clarke County, Indiana in the 10th IN Cavalry Regiment Company E. He was promoted to full "Comm" Sergeant and mustered out on 15 July 1865. Another record states he deserted on 15 July 1865.

He was listed as a Confederate P.O.W. in Louisville, Kentucky with the rank of private while serving with the 30th GA Co. E, captured in Bibb County on 7 October 1863 and was released the next month after taking the oath. After taking the oath he was sent north of the Ohio River.

His in enlistment record from Georgia says he enlisted in Co. D of the 30th, but the P.O.W. record says Co. E of the 30th GA.
